# **Bench Etiquette**

Yelling at referees will NEVER help your team win; nobody likes being yelled at.

STEP DOWN off the bench.

Talk to referees as if their parent is beside you (because mom and dad probably are).









# **Rostered Players and Bench Staff**

- Never allow a player or official who is NOT listed on the game sheet to participate in the game.
- PCAHA is very strict about this and will suspend coaches if it happens.

# Team Operations: Game Play

Have a paper game sheet handy
but ONLY use if there are technical problems.
Refs must sign the game sheet.

As a last resort, they can sign the paper game sheet.
Email a photo to your PCAHA league manager if this happens.

- Use Hisports (now called Spordle Play) on tablet or phone web browser -https://hisports.app/login
- Review and sign off on your team roster in Hisports before the game starts
   If a player is missing or there is an error, email the Registrar.
- Referee Payments

  Cash payments ready for referees in the scorekeeper's box. Amount varies depending on division. Check PCAHA website.

  BMHA cheque for referee payments given to head coach directly. Coordinate to add to team funds for referee payments.

## **Team Operations**

- Parent Meeting no later than November 15<sup>th</sup>
  - Teamsnap contact info, availability (Hockey Canada medical form was part of registration forms, verify you can access in TS)
  - Team Budget
  - Volunteers
  - Sportsmanship Starts In the Stands
    - Email your DM with Team Name (ie U15C1 or WCU13A1), Date of parent meeting and how many parents in attendance
  - Tournaments for Rep teams, it is a blind vote. Use Google Survey. 75% yes for an out of town tournament.
    - If a player can't make it, they still pay as it is a team cost







# Parent Meeting Requirements

BC Hockey requires that all Minor Hockey Associations, host a Parent Meeting prior to November 15 annually and must contain...

- Review of key MHA Policies and Procedures i.e., Locker Room, Team Selection, Ice Times
- Review of the Association complaint process / policy
- Code of Conduct expectations
- Each Team must advise DM of
  - Date of Parent Meeting
  - Number of parents attended
  - Team details ie U11 C2, WC U15A1

Failure to comply with this requirement will result in the cancellation of BC Hockey sanctioning for events hosted or operated by the Minor Hockey Association.

NOTE: Unsanctioned events are not eligible for coverage under the Hockey Canada Insurance

  - Supposed to wear Association Jersey colour (except in conflict and then home team has to resolve conflict)
- Jersey Deposit Cheque \$200, payable to BMHA, post-dated April 1, 2024
  - U11 "C" teams only \$100, if keeping one of AtoMc jerseys
  - Cheques cashed if lost or damage was preventable
- BMHA jerseys for games only
  - No alteration (name bars, sponsorship patches)
  - A's & C's gently sewn by hand do not machine sew or iron
  - Hang dry jersey. Knit socks will shrink in dryer
  - Team jersey inventory log



Note 1: BC Hockey requires that each team designate a Head Coach.

Note 2: Each team must have at least one qualified Team Safety Person registered. Failure to have a qualified Team Safety Person registered with the team on or before **December 1st** will result in the team being ineligible for playoffs. Where there are no playoffs (U9 and below), fines or other disciplinary action will result.

Note 3: All team officials must submit a current Criminal Record Check (CRC) and Vulnerable Sector (VS) check prior to participation.

Note 4: Development 1 Coaches must complete maintenance modules (professional development) to retain certification.

Note 5: Coaches who acquired Coach 2 - Coach Level in 2016-2017 or prior are also qualified at Coach 1 - Intro to Coach Level.

Note 6: Beginning in 2020-2021 the Coach 2 - Coach Level clinic includes the Checking Qualification module.

Note 7: On-ice helpers rostered in HCR are not Team Officials and may not participate in games in any capacity.

# When in doubt, ask!

#### **Team Officials**

- Criminal Record Check must be completed, or you cannot work with the kids or be rostered
- Be present HCSP must be in attendance for every ice time
- Rule of Two
- Ensure certifications are updated as required
- Wear proper gear on ice
- Ensure only rostered officials are on the ice /bench







# Risk Management

#### **Escalation Process**

- Parent → Team Manager → Coach → DM → Executive
- 24-Hour Rule

#### Discipline

- BMHA Policy 20.101
- Coach can suspend player for up to 2 games (U11 and up)
- Suspensions more than 2 games must be approved by Executive
